And now for the legal stuff – the rules..... **Terms and Conditions**

2. By entering the Livewire “Win an iPod Touch” competition, you agree to accept these terms and conditions. Information about prizes and how to enter form part of these terms and conditions.
3. Entry is open to young people aged over 10 and under 21 years of age who are Australian residents and have registered at livewire.org.au within in the time periods specified in the competition terms.
4. The Livewire “Win an iPod Touch” competition starts on 29th May, 2009 at 5.00pm and concludes on 28th August 2009 at 3.00pm. The lucky winner’s name will be drawn on the 7th September, 2009 at 10am at the Livewire office, 80 Chandos Street, St Leonards.
5. To enter, during the competition period, entrants must log onto the Livewire website (livewire.org.au) and Join Livewire. You have registered correctly when you have clicked on the ‘Join Livewire Now’ button and followed all the required steps.
